Take I-5 Northbound to Exit 107 Pacific Avenue, Turn right onto Pacific;
stay on Pacific Ave

ROUTES TO THE SHOW

Both Northbound & Southbound on I-5, Take Chehalis Exit #79, Chambers Way.
Turn East off the exit onto Chambers Way.

Go to the second stop light and turn left onto National Avenue, which is a
one-way street going north. National Avenue turns into Kresky Avenue.
For the North Parking Lot, continue north on Kresky Avenue and turn left on Fair
Street, then left on Gold Street. The North Parking Lot will be on the right side.
Overnight Parking will enter through the North Gate, no Day Parking will be
allowed in the North End gate. Day Parking will enter through a gate at the
SOUTH end. You will be directed to unload or day parking.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS & VENDORS

- The Show Site will be available to exhibitors and vendors on
Wednesday at 10:00AM
- Per AKC Rules: NO VEHICLES MAY DRIVE ON THE GROUNDS
WHILE SHOW IS IN PROGRESS
- NO ROLLER BLADES, SKATEBOARDS, OR BICYCLES ON
FAIRGROUNDS.
- NO PARKING AGAINST ANY BUILDING ON FAIRGROUNDS.
- NO SMOKING ON THE FAIRGROUNDS. Smoking (lighted pipe,
cigar, cigarette, or any other lighted or electronic smoking equipment,) or use
of marijuana, or marijuana-infused products on the Southwest Washington
Fairgrounds public places are UNLAWFUL and STRICTLY PROHIBITED
per RCW 70.160.030 and RCW 69.50.445.
- Exhibitors and vendors must vacate Fairgrounds by 7:00PM on
Sunday.

- No dogs that are disqualified for aggression will be allowed to enter
these shows, nor be allowed on the grounds. In addition, no aggression
reinstatement procedures will be performed at these shows.
- The club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official
American Kennel Club entry form for event.

THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ANY ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT.

PSSSS will not refund any
Entry fees if a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the
Judge or Veterinarian, barred from competition by action of the Show
Committee, or because it was entered incorrectly. There is no refund of
the entry fee for bitches in season, except for bitches entered in Junior
Showmanship, Obedience, or Rally. There is no refund for DUPLICATE
ENTRIES OR, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond
the control of the management, if it is impossible to hold the show. No
dogs will be allowed in the show area except those entered. The judging
will start promptly. Dogs may arrive anytime before their time of judging
and may leave immediately afterward unless required for further judging.
Exhibitors are responsible for having their dog ready to be shown and at
the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class.

FOR LOSS AND OR DAMAGES: The Show Committee will use due
care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors. The Show
Committee and Event Secretary will not be responsible for or assume any
liability in the case of any injury or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors
participating in this event. The responsibility and welfare of an exhibitor's
child are assumed to be the exhibitor's responsibility. All exhibitors will
exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show.
The Club has the right to substitute a prize for equal or more value.
Trophies must be claimed on the day of the show. No prizes will be
mailed or otherwise distributed.

SWEEPSTAKES CASH PRIZES are awarded to the handler showing the
dog while in the ring. Prize Money Claims for the prize money must be
made while in the ring and before the breed judging is over. The Show
Secretary and The Club disclaim any liability for cash prize after the
Breed judging is over.

ALL PERSONS ATTENDING THIS DOG SHOW waive any claim for
damages against THE CLUB, its members, or agents in the event that a
motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or
suffocation due to improper ventilation. The CLUB, its show secretaries,
their agents, employees, etc, will use due care and diligence for the
welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will assume no responsibility for any
loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their
dogs or property participating in these shows, and further assumes no
responsibility for injury to children at these shows. Any exhibitor or
person they employ found to be littering or failing to clean up after their
dogs will be brought before the Event Committee. The CLUB does not
agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official American Kennel Club
entry form for this event. No dog shall be left unattended in any closed
vehicle.
