be accepted. Changes, additions, or corrections to the entry form must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. Those received by phone will not be acceptable. An administrative fee of \$2.00 will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to the closing of entries. Refunds of \$3.50 or less will not be issued due to the processing costs. All refunds will not be mailed out until after the show. Returned checks or declined credit or debit cards do not count as a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. Checks will not be accepted. The Show Secretary will add a \$32.00 fee to the amount of the check for completing the transaction and reprocessing entries.

Chapter 11, Section 1. No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for s entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration. For complete detail see Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 1. Effective January 1, 2026 Chapter 11 Section 2 The American Kennel Club will collect a \$4.00 Event Service Fee for the first entry of a dog and a \$4.50 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single-entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. (There is no recording fee or event service fee for sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes, or special attractions.) The current 50 cent recording will continue to be collected. The event-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Event Service Fees for the American Kennel Club. That fact shall be stated in the premium list. These event service and recording fees shall be forwarded to the American Kennel Club along with all other required event results within seven (7) days of the close of the event.

ACKNOWLEDGMENTS: Entries will be acknowledged after the entries have closed. Entry acknowledgment and judging program to be sent to the email address on entry. Should an exhibitor NOT receive the entry acknowledgment within a reasonable time, please notify the Show Secretary at the address provided. PSSSS will not accept any entry that includes or specifies any conditions. Telephone, telegraph, fax, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will get returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and or Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the dog owner or agent who entered a dog in a class that the dog is not eligible to compete in.

THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ANY ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT. PSSSS will not refund any Entry fees if a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it was entered incorrectly. There is no refund of the entry fee for bitches in season, except for bitches enter in Junior Showmanship, Obedience, or Rally. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES OR, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, if it is impossible to hold the show. No dogs will be allowed in the show area except those entered. The judging will start promptly. Dogs may arrive anytime before their time of judging and may leave immediately afterward unless required for further judging. Exhibitors are responsible for having their dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class.

FOR LOSS AND OR DAMAGES: The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors. The Show Committee and Event Secretary will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the case of any injury or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this event. The responsibility and welfare of an exhibitor's child are assumed to be the exhibitor's responsibility. All exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show. The Club has the right to substitute a prize for equal or more value. Trophies must be claimed on the day of the show. No prizes will be mailed or otherwise distributed.

SWEEPSTAKES CASH PRIZES are awarded to the handler showing the dog while in the ring. Prize Money Claims for the prize money must be made while in the ring and before the breed judging is over. The Show Secretary and The Club disclaim any liability for cash prize after the Breed judging is over.

All PERSONS ATTENDING THIS DOG SHOW waive any claim for damages against THE CLUB, its members, or agents in the event that a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation. The CLUB, its show secretaries, their agents, employees, etc, will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property participating in these shows, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children at these shows. Any exhibitors or person they employ found to be littering or failing to clean up after their dogs will be brought before the Event Committee. The CLUB does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official american kennel club entry form for this event. no dog shall be left unattended in any closed vehicle.

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 3 pm on Monday, May 4, 2026. No exhibitors may set up grooming equipment prior to 3 pm. Dogs and all equipment must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging Friday, May 8, 2026.

Exhibitor and visitor parking will be located on blacktop parking lots in front of Purina Event Center. Vehicles are limited to ONE PARKING SPACE. No ex-pens or crates allowed on blacktop, but are allowed on grass areas. No cones allowed in parking areas. NO PARKING IN ROADWAYS or next to building.

RV PARKING There are seventy-six RV parking spaces located behind the Purina Event Center, with 50 and 30 amp electric, sewer and water hookup (water may not be available in winter months). Once all of the RV parking spaces behind the Purina Event Center are full, then the Overflow lot would be used. Reservations should be made directly with Purina, see Rules and RV Parking Application later in this premium and on the ECSCA website.

GROOMING & CRATING Grooming and crating in designated areas only. Grooming in the Purina Event Center will be 5 x 10 foot spaces. The fee for grooming with electricity is \$75.00 for the entire event (see grooming space application at the end of this premium list or at the ECSCA website <https://englishcocker.org/2026-national/>). Reservations will be accepted until Wednesday, April 8, 2026 at 2:00 pm CT/12:00 pm PT. There will be limited free grooming spaces available with no electric. The free grooming area will be clearly marked. Exhibitors are expected to stack crates and limit the number of grooming tables to maximize space. All Grooming Tables must have rubber or plastic caps on the end of legs. All Grooming Exhibitors are responsible for keeping their grooming areas as clean as possible each day and cleaning up all hair in your space before leaving the site. Any crates in Great Hall MUST have a covering underneath them, whether it is a towel, rug, plastic, etc. to help protect floor from damage. Crates placed ringside for showing MUST be

removed immediately after the showing of your dog, they may not be left overnight. The Purina Event Center will be available at 3:00 pm on Monday, May 4, 2026. Bathing of dogs is restricted to bathing area of the building - no dogs allowed in restrooms. The Purina Event Center will close and doors will be locked at 10:00 pm and will re-open at 6:00 am. Guards will be on duty. Dogs may be left inside the building on Monday through Thursday nights only. In accordance with AKC policy, each dog that is left in the facility overnight must be identified with a tag stating the owner/agent's name and where they can be reached in case of an emergency. In the event of multiple entries, one tag will be sufficient provided it clearly outlines the number of dogs and the area in which they are crated. No cones, baby strollers, ex-pens, cocker pens or puppy pens allowed inside the building at any time. Please stack your crates and limit the number of grooming tables. All vehicles must leave their headlights on while loading and unloading in the designated loading/unloading areas which are clearly marked. No vehicles may park in roadways to unload.

EXHIBITORS & GUESTS No one is permitted anywhere that is marked "Employees Only" and/or "No Admittance". These are separate divisions of Purina and are not part of the show grounds. No dogs are allowed on the second floor of the Purina Event Center. No baby strollers, private golf carts, firearms or cones allowed on Purina Property or inside Purina Event Center.

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - none will be mailed. All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days. The Superintendent is not able to cash checks. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

If confirmed, you will receive an emailed confirmation and a payment link so you can pay at your convenience. Our RV Engagement Specialist will respond back to your reservation request within 5–7 business days to let you know whether your reservation is confirmed. Full payment must be received before the space can be finalized.

Purina Farms offers 2 different RV lots on property. The **Full Service** Purina Event Center RV lot offers 30 and 50 amp electric, water and sewer. The **Electric Only** Main Show Field RV lot offers 30 and 50 amp electric.

POINTS FOR RESERVE

Chapter 16 Section 1 Rules Applying to Dog Shows ... at the National Specialty the dog designated Reserve Winners Dog and the bitch designated Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winner's sex totals at least twice the number required for a five point major, in the region in which the event is held.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES)

Field Class

Field Class Dog: Open to any English Cocker Spaniel Dog or Bitch eligible to regularly compete at a show that has earned the ECSCA Working Dog (WD) or Working Dog Excellent (WDX) Title, or an AKC Field Championship (FC), Hunting Title (JH, SH, MH) or has placed in a stake at an AKC Cocker/English Cocker Spaniel Field Trial. Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" Neutered dogs and spayed bitches would be allowed to compete in the Field Class. Judging will be on conformation only, and the winner of the Field Dog and the Field Bitch classes may compete for Best of Breed Competition if otherwise undefeated in a breed class at this show.

Veteran Class

Veteran Classes - Class for dogs & class for bitches seven (7) yrs & under ten (10) yrs.
Veteran Classes - Class for dogs & class for bitches ten (10) yrs & over. Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" Neutered dogs and spayed bitches would be allowed to compete in Veterans and all other single entry non-regular classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed. Winners of the Veteran Classes will compete for Best of Breed (Variety), if undefeated.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES)

Stud Dog Class - For Stud Dogs and two (2) of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Award will be based on the merits of the Get. While the merit of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determined if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusable under Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the Standard for the breed. If the Stud Dog or Get are not entered in one of the other classes at this show for which it is eligible, the regular entry fee must be paid for each. Entry fee for the Stud Dog Class as an "Additional Class" is for the unit.

Brood Bitch Class - Same as Stud Dog Class, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. Note; in Accordance with Chapter 11, Section 8, a neutered male may be entered in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered in the Brood Bitch Class.

Brace Class - For Two (2) dogs of the same breed and which must have one common owner and be presented by a maximum of two handlers. All Braces must be entered in the Brace Class and shown in the ring at the same time. Dogs may be entered for Brace Class competition only or as an additional entry. The dogs comprising Brace must be named at the time of the entry. In making entries for "Brace Class only", all particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space for "Additional Classes". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be so designated. "Brace No. 1", "Brace No. 2". Entry Fee for Brace as a first entry is \$37.00 per dog and \$30.00 for the unit as an "Additional Entry".

Team Class - Same as Brace Class, except for Four (4) dogs of the same breed which must have one common owner and be presented by a maximum of four handlers. As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Brace and Team Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged First in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

NOTE: Teams and Brace units MUST send a complete list of the dogs in their unit (Reg. AKC Names) to secretary@patriciashawss.com prior to closing (or include one with mailed entries). If multiple co-owners, please chose ONE person to send ONE list. ENTRIES MARKED TEAM/BRACE WITHOUT AN ACCOMPANYING LISTING IN A UNIT WILL BE CONSIDERED INCOMPLETE AND WILL NOT BE ENTERED IN THE CLASS.

Parade of Titleholders - There will be a non-competitive Parade of Titleholders. Any English Cocker Spaniel Champion of Record holding an AKC or ECSCA recognized title is eligible. Please include a brief resume (250 words or less) of the dog's accomplishments to be read at ringside.

Award of Merit for Superior Quality - At the discretion of the judge, up to THREE Awards of Merit from dogs/bitches in Best of Breed may be awarded.

Best Bred-By-Exhibitor and BBE Eligibility - All dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be individually registered with AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. Family members must be both a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in the class. Any entry in the Bred-By-Exhibitor classes that is awarded Best of Breed or Best of Winners would automatically be Best Bred-By-Exhibitor. Only the dog or bitch not defeated in Bred-By-Exhibitor Class are eligible for the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor competition. Best Bred-By-Exhibitor will be selected from the winners of the Bred-By-Exhibitor Puppy Classes (6-12 mos.) and the Bred-By-Exhibitor Adult Classes (12 mos. and over) at the conclusion of Best of Competition.

Best Puppy - Any entry in the puppy classes that is awarded Best of Breed or Best of Winners would automatically be Best Puppy. Only dogs not defeated in a puppy class are eligible for Best Puppy Competition.

Best in Veteran Class - Any entry in the Veteran Class that is awarded Best of Breed would automatically be Best in Veteran Class. Only dogs not defeated in Veteran Class are eligible for Best In Veteran Competition.

Children between 5 years to under 9 years can join the fun of dog showing. This class is being offered to inspire young handlers to love and show their dogs. This event is for exhibition only and there will be no placement of the entries. All children will receive the same participation award from the judge. Dogs are to be AKC recognized English Cocker Spaniels and at least 4 months old. Children enter the ring with their dog one at a time. For more information, contact The Club. Prior to the beginning of the class, the responsible adult will sign a RELEASE OF LIABILITY FORM. Each child will receive a Rosette and participation gift. Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate. A dog may be substituted that meets the eligibility requirements as specified by the Club. All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar. A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring. A release must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian. This release will be available onsite and must be signed before going into the ring. The safety of both the dogs and juniors inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside of the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. An additional lead, provided by The Club, will be at the Judge's table. At the judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.

One combined class will be offered for dogs that are four months and under six months as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. There will be a selection of Best of Breed Puppy.

Dogs must be four months of age and under six months. Dogs are required to be vaccinated in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized. AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in Rules applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise. AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy for the judges. Classes will not be divided by sex in this competition. Breed standard disqualifications such as color, height, weight or dentition shall not be a point of consideration in the judging process for this 4-6 month Puppy Special Attraction event.

Professional Handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this class. Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES)

Field Class

Field Class Dog: Open to any English Cocker Spaniel Dog or Bitch eligible to regularly compete at a show that has earned the ECSCA Working Dog (WD) or Working Dog Excellent (WDX) Title, or an AKC Field Championship (FC), Hunting Title (JH, SH, MH) or has placed in a stake at an AKC Cocker/English Cocker Spaniel Field Trial.

Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" Neutered dogs and spayed bitches would be allowed to compete in the Field Class. Judging will be on conformation only, and the winner of the Field Dog and the Field Bitch classes may compete for Best of Breed Competition if otherwise undefeated in a breed class at this show.

Veteran Class

Veteran Classes - Class for dogs & class for bitches seven (7) yrs & under ten (10) yrs.

Veteran Classes - Class for dogs & class for bitches ten (10) yrs & over. Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" Neutered dogs and spayed bitches would be allowed to compete in Veterans and all other single entry non-regular classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed. Winners of the Veteran Classes will compete for Best of Breed (Variety), if undefeated.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Award of Merit for Superior Quality - At the discretion of the judge, up to THREE Awards of Merit from dogs/bitches in Best of Breed may be awarded.

Best Bred-By-Exhibitor and BBE Eligibility - All dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be individually registered with AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. Family members must be both a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in the class. Any entry in the Bred-By-Exhibitor classes that is awarded Best of Breed or Best of Winners would automatically be Best Bred-By-Exhibitor. Only the dog or bitch not defeated in Bred-By-Exhibitor Class are eligible for the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor competition. Best Bred-By-Exhibitor will be selected from the winners of the Bred-By-Exhibitor Puppy Classes (6-12 mos.) and the Bred-By-Exhibitor Adult Classes (12 mos. and over) at the conclusion of Best of Competition.

Best Puppy - Any entry in the puppy classes that is awarded Best of Breed or Best of Winners would automatically be Best Puppy. Only dogs not defeated in a puppy class are eligible for Best Puppy Competition.

Best in Veteran Class - Any entry in the Veteran Class that is awarded Best of Breed would automatically be Best in Veteran Class. Only dogs not defeated in Veteran Class are eligible for Best In Veteran Competition

Novice Class – For boys and girls at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in a Novice Class without competition leading to a Best Junior with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

Open Class - For boys and girls at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with completion present it will count as one win toward moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Novice and Open Class Divided: Junior - 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show. **Intermediate** - 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show: **Senior** - 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

Master Junior Class - This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility date for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NATIONAL PERFORMANCE CHALLENGE FAQs

What is the NPC and How is it Determined?

The ECSCA National Performance Challenge (NPC) recognizes dog/handler teams with the top cumulative performance scores at the National Specialty each year. One team will be selected as the overall winner of the National Performance Challenge, along with four runners up. NPC scores will be assigned based on a pre-determined point system, that was established by the ECSCA and is available on its website (<https://englishcocker.org/2026-national/>).

Each year's NPC is based on qualifying scores at performance events offered at that year's National Specialty. Teams may enter as many events and classes as they are eligible for. However, each event will only be counted once (towards the NPC) regardless of how many times that event is offered, or how many individual classes are offered. When an event is offered multiple times, on multiple days, and/or has multiple classes offered, the highest qualifying score earned for that event will be used in determining the NPC winners. In addition, bonus points will be awarded to teams qualifying in 3 to 7 events. The bonus point system is described on the ECSCA website.

The 2026 NPC Details and How to Be Considered

To be considered for these awards, a team must enter at least 3 events and must qualify in at least 2 of them.

The events offered at the 2026 National that are eligible for the NPC are:

- Hunt tests – 2 days (JH, SH, MH)
- Working test – 1 day (WD, WDX)
- Tracking – 1 day (TD, TDX)
- Agility trials – 2 days [Standard, JWW, FAST, T2B (all levels, regular and preferred)]
- Scent work – 1 day, 2 trials (Novice, Advanced, Excellent)
- Obedience – 1 day [Beg Novice, Novice (includes Preferred and Veterans), Pre-Open, Open, Pre-Utility, Utility, Versatility, Graduate classes (Novice and Open)]
- Rally – 1 day (Novice, Intermediate, Advanced, Excellent, Masters, Choice)

Teams must sign up in advance to indicate which events/classes/dates they have entered. No NPC registrations will be accepted at the show. This information will be used to track each team's results and tabulate scores. There is an online NPC Registration Form to record all your entry information. You will need to create a form for EACH dog you want considered for the NPC. You will receive an acknowledgement for each form you complete. Please keep these for your records.

The link for the NPC Registration Form is on the 2026 ECSCA National Specialty page on the website. The deadline for completing the form is Wednesday, April 8, 2026. No late registration forms will be accepted.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as AKC Canine Partners Listed Dog "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
