Attention Exhibitors

Exhibitor Rule Change Effective 01/01/2010. Chapter 11. Section 1. No dog can enter in a licensed or member dog show: unless it is either; individually registered with the American Kennel Club; or is individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration For complete detail, see Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 1

Effective for all events held on and after January 1, 2008; The American Kennel Club will collect a \$3.00 event service fee for the first entry of a dog, and a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entries, of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, in all AKC, licensed and member club events. (America Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). The current 50 cents recording fee will continue to be collected where applicable. The event-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all the Events Service Fees for the American Kennel Club. The American Kennel Club must receive all fees within seven (7) days of the close of the event, along with all other required event results.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS: Entries will be acknowledged after the entries have close. Entry acknowledgment and judging program to be sent to the address on entry. Should an exhibitor NOT receive the entry acknowledgment within a reasonable time, please notify the Show Secretary at the address provided. No entry will be accepted, which includes or specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telephone, telegraph, fax, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will get returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and, or Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the dog owner or agent who entered a dog in a class that the dog is not eligible to compete. THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COM-PLETENESS OF ANY ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT. Entries fee; will not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has entered incorrectly. There is no refund of the entry fee for bitches in season expect for those entered in Junior Showmanship, Obedience or Rally.. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to hold the show.

No dogs will be allowed in the show area except those regularly entered in the show. The judging will start promptly. Dogs may arrive anytime before their time of judging and may leave immediately afterward unless required for further judging. Exhibit ors are responsible for having their dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. FOR LOSS AND OR DAMAGES: The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors. The Show Committee and Event Secretary will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the case of any injury or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this event. The responsibility and welfare of an exhibitor's child are assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. All exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show.

- •Your dog(s) must be on a leash while in public areas, hallways, and Hotel grounds.
- •Dogs are not permitted in dining areas, swimming pool areas, or fitness and business centers.
- •Guests must crate their dog(s) in guestrooms when owners are not present. All crates must have plastic or protective sheets under them. The owner must be in the room while any hotel staff member is servicing the guestroom (housekeeping, engineering, etc.) when a dog is in the room.
