### Attention Exhibitors

Exhibitor Rule Change Effective 01/01/2010. Chapter 11, Section 1. No dog can enter a licensed or member dog show unless it is either; individually registered with the American Kennel Club, or is individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration. For complete detail, see Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 1. Effective for all events held on and after January 1, 2008 The American Kennel Club will collect a \$3.00 event service fee for the first entry of a dog, and a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). The current 50 cents recording fee will continue to be collected where applicable. The event-giving Club shall be responsible for collecting all the Events Service Fees for the American Kennel Club. The American Kennel Club must receive all fees within seven (7) days of the close of the event, along with all other required event results.

**ACKNOWLEDGMENTS:** Entries will be acknowledged after the entries have closed. Entry acknowledgment and judging program to be sent to the address on entry. Should an exhibitor NOT receive the entry acknowledgment within a reasonable time, please notify the Show Secretary at the address provided. PSSSS will not accept any entry that includes or specifies any conditions. Telephone, telegraph, fax, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will get returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and or Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the dog owner or agent who entered a dog in a class that the dog is not eligible to compete in. THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ANY ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT. PSSSS will not refund any Entry fees if a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it was entered incorrectly. **There is no refund of the entry fee for bitches in season, except for bitches enter in Junior Showmanship, Obedience, or Rally.** There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES OR, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, if it is impossible to hold the show.

**No dogs will be allowed** in the show area except those entered. The judging will start promptly. Dogs may arrive anytime before their time of judging and may leave immediately afterward unless required for further judging. Exhibitors are responsible for having their dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class.

**FOR LOSS AND OR DAMAGES:** The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors. The Show Committee and Event Secretary will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the case of any injury or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this event. The responsibility and welfare of an exhibitor's child are assumed to be the exhibitor's responsibility. All exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show.

**The Club has the right to substitute a prize** for equal or more value. Trophies must be claimed on the day of the show. No prizes will be mailed or otherwise distributed.

**SWEEPSTAKES CASH PRIZES** are awarded to the handler showing the dog while in the ring. Prize Money Claims for the prize money must be made while in the ring and before the breed judging is over. The Show Secretary and The Club disclaim any liability for cash prize after the Breed judging is over.

**All PERSONS ATTENDING THIS DOG SHOW** waive any claim for damages against THE CLUB, its members, or agents in the event that a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

**THE CLUB, ITS SHOW SECRETARIES, THEIR AGENTS, EMPLOYEES, ETC. ### **RESERVE WINNERS**

At the National Specialty, the dog designated Reserve Winners Dog and the bitch designated Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winner's sex totals at least twice the number required for a five point major in the region in which the event is held. No major for Reserve Winners shall be given based upon an award of Best of Winners. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, or from which all awards are withheld, shall not be included.

#### ***English Setter Association of America***

#### ***VERSATILITY SHOWCASE***

To recognize and honor those who have earned Versatile English Setter (VES) awards by virtue of successfully competing in at least three different venues with their English Setters, the handlers and their dogs, will enter the ring with the dogs on leash, have their names and titles read, and be presented a ribbon inscribed with the dog's name and VES title achieved. Only dogs and handlers present at the National will participate in the Showcase.

This is a combined version of the AKC Regulations (regarding the 4-6 Month Puppy) and we refer to the regulation for a full description of this class. One combined class will be offered for dogs that are four months and under six months as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*. There will be a selection of Best of Breed Puppy.

Dogs must be four months of age and under six months. Dogs are required to be vaccinated in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized. AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in Rules applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise. AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy for the judges. Classes will not be divided by sex in this competition. Breed standard disqualifications such as color, height, weight or dentition shall not be a point of consideration in the judging process for this 4-6 month Puppy Special Attraction event.

Professional Handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this class. Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler.

All entrants in the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy class will receive an ESAA pendant and ribbon.

For Dogs & Bitches who have a placement in a senior stake (e.g. Gun Dog or All Age) or a first in a Derby Stake at an AKC Licensed Field Trial.

#### Hunting Dog Class

For Dogs & Bitches that have achieved any AKC Hunting Title (Junior, Senior or Master) or the ESAA Hunt Dog title.

Winners of the Veteran, Field Trial and Hunting Dog Classes will compete for Best of Breed (Variety), if undefeated.

#### Best of Breed Competition

**Best of Breed Competition :** The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed/Variety Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed/Variety Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

**Award of Merit for Superior Quality: (ESAA)** At the discretion of the judge, up to five awards of Merit from dogs/bitches in Best of Breed may be awarded.

**Best Bred-By-Exhibitor and BBE Eligibility** - All dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be individually registered with AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. Family members must be both a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in the class. Any entry in the Bred-By- Exhibitor classes that is awarded Best of Breed or Best of Winners would automatically be Best Bred-By-Exhibitor. Only the dog or bitch not defeated in Bred-By-Exhibitor are eligible for the Best Bred-By -Exhibitor competition.

**Best Puppy** - Any entry in the puppy classes that is awarded Best of Breed or Best of Winners would automatically be Best Puppy. Only dogs not defeated in a puppy class are eligible for Best Puppy Competition. Best Bred By Puppy will be able to compete for both Best Puppy and Best Bred By Exhibitor.

**Best in Veteran Class.** - Any entry in the Veteran class that is awarded Best of Breed would automatically be Best in Veteran Class. Only dogs not defeated in Veteran class are eligible for Best In Veteran Competition.

#### Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple dog entries)

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

**Stud Dog Class – National Only** – For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but MUST be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get MUST be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

**Brood Bitch Class – National Only** – Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

**Brace Class - National Only** – A brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. **Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. All dogs must be entered in another class. Team Class - National Only Team Class** - Same as Brace, but has four dogs of the same recognized Breed, and a maximum of four handlers.

### **CLASS DIVISIONS: Classes to be divided into dogs and bitches.**

Junior – For dogs that have earned a Junior Hunter, OR ESAA HD title, OR have placed in a Puppy or Derby stake.

Senior – For dogs that have earned a Senior Hunter, OR ESAA HDX title, OR have placed in a broke dog stake

Master – For dogs that have earned a Master Hunter title, OR have a broke dog major
