Changes, additions or correction to entry form must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by phone will not be acceptable. An administrative fee of \$2.00 will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries. Refunds of \$3.50 or less will not be issued due to the costs of processing. All refunds will not be mailed out until after the show.

RETURNED CHECKS, DECLINED CREDIT OR DEBIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. Checks will not be accepted. The Show Secretary will add a \$32.00 fee to the amount of the check for completing the transaction and or reprocessing the entries.

NO PUPPIES LESS THAN 4 MONTHS OLD WILL BE PERMITTED ON THE SHOWGROUNDS (HOTEL PROPERTY), AND THERE WILL BE NO PUPPIES OFFERED FOR SALE.

Attention Exhibitors

Chapter 11, Section 1. No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration. For complete detail see Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 1.

Effective January 1, 2026 Chapter 11 Section 2

The American Kennel Club will collect a \$4.00 Event Service Fee for the first entry of a dog and a \$4.50 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single-entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. (There is no recording fee or event service fee for sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes, or special attractions.) The current 50 cent recording will continue to be collected. The event-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Event Service Fees for the American Kennel Club. That fact shall be stated in the premium list. These event service and recording fees shall be forwarded to the American Kennel Club along with all other required event results within seven (7) days of the close of the event.

Acknowledgments: Acknowledgments of Entries will be after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to the address on entries. Please notify the Show Secretary at the address provided should the exhibitor NOT receive a confirmation of the entry within a reasonable time. No entry will be accepted, which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telephone, telegraph, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent or entered a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete. THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ANY ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT.

The Event Secretary shall not refund the entry fees if a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has entered incorrectly.

There is no refund of the entry fee for bitches in season unless entered in Junior Showmanship, Obedience, or Rally. Written certification by a licensed veterinarian must be received at least a half-hour before the start of all judging on the trial date is required for refund of entry fees to entrants of bitches in these trials to the effect that the bitch is in season on the day of the Junior Showmanship, Obedience, or Rally event. There is no refund for **DUPLICATE ENTRIES**. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the Show, There will be no refund of fees. No dogs will be allowed in the show area except those regularly entered in the Show. The judging will start promptly. Dogs may arrive anytime prior to their time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class.

LOSS OR DAMAGE: The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this Event.

The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the Show.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians recommendation to assure their dog are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All Trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed or otherwise distributed.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the persons showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that Breed is over and the show secretary's office is advised at once. The Show Secretary and Show giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prize after the judging of the Breed is over.

For everyone's safety no baby strollers or wheeled child carriers are allowed on the show grounds.

All PERSONS ATTENDING THIS DOG SHOW hereby waive any claim for damages against Golden Gate Pembroke Welsh Corgi Fanciers, Inc. its members, or agents, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

Golden Gate Pembroke Welsh Corgi Fanciers, inc. its Show Secretaries, their agents, employees, etc. will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property participating in these shows, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children at these shows.

CLASSIFICATION-PEMBROKE WELSH CORGI

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches:

REGULAR CLASSES

- Puppy (6 mos. & under 9 mos.)
- Puppy (9 mos. & under 12 mos.)
- 12 mos. & under 18 mos.
- Bred-By-Exhibitor Puppy 6-12 months
- Bred-By-Exhibitor Adult 12 months & over
- American Bred
- Open

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES)

- Veteran Class (7 yrs & under 10 yrs Old)
- Veteran Class (10 yrs & Older)

The winners of veteran classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed. Any veterans defeated in these classes may not compete for Best of Breed, even if entered in the class. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veterans Classes only at independent specialties shows. Only a First Place winner will be selected. All other exhibitors shall receive participation rosettes.

Herding Titled Class - Class for dogs/bitches that has achieved a Herding Title (HT, PT, HS, JL, HX, HCh). By virtue of winning this class, the dog/bitch is entitled to compete for best of breed.

Best of Breed Competition - The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed/Variety Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed/Variety Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

Award of Merit for Superior Quality: Award of Merit may be given at the Judge's discretion to no more than five (5) exhibits of the Best of Breed class at its conclusion, with the exception of Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed.

Best Bred-By-Exhibitor and BBE Eligibility - All dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be individually registered with AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. Family members must be both a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in the class. Any entry in the Bred-By-Exhibitor classes that is awarded Best of Breed or Best of Winners would automatically be Best Bred-By-Exhibitor. Only the dog or bitch not defeated in Bred-By-Exhibitor are eligible for the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor competition. The winners of BBE Puppy and BBE Adult classes can compete for Best Bred-By Exhibitor.

Best Puppy - Any entry in the puppy classes and puppy BBE classes that is awarded Best of Breed or Best of Winners would automatically be Best Puppy. Only dogs not defeated in a puppy class or puppy BBE are eligible for Best Puppy Competition. Puppy class winners and Puppy BBE winners can compete for Best Puppy.

Best in American Bred Class - Any entry in the American bred class that is awarded Best of Breed or Best of Winners would automatically be Best in American Bred Class. Only dogs not defeated in American bred class are eligible for Best In American Bred Competition.

Best in Veteran Class - Any entry in the Veteran class that is awarded Best of Breed would automatically be Best in Veteran Class. Only dogs not defeated in Veteran class are eligible for Best In Veteran Competition.

Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple dog entries)

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, not one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Stud Dog Class – For Stud Dogs at least two and no more than four of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

Brood Bitch Class – Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

SWEEPSTAKES

Requirements & Classification

Sweepstakes is open to all Pembroke Welsh Corgis who, on the day of the show, will be 6 months of age and under 18 months of age. Champions of Record are not eligible. All entries entered in the Friday Sweepstakes MUST also be entered in a regular conformation class on Saturday. Entries must be made at the same time on the same entry form as for the Regular entry, with the Sweepstakes class shown as "Additional Class", giving the age division and including the additional fee as listed on the official AKC Entry Form.

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches:

- Puppy 6 mos. & under 9 mos.
- Puppy 9 mos. & under 12 mos.
- Junior 12 mos. & under 15 mos.
- Junior 15 mos. & under 18 mos.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Requirements & Classification

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all registered dogs that are 7 years of age or older on the day of the show. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered in Veteran Sweepstakes. Entrants may or may not be finished champions. Dogs shown in Veteran Sweepstakes need not be entered in one of the regular classes or at the regular entry fee. Veteran Sweepstakes will be judged prior to regular classes. Indicate your Veteran Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional class".

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches

- Veterans, 7 yrs & Under 10 yrs
- Veterans 10 yrs & Older

BEST IN SWEEPSTAKES & BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX TO BEST IN SWEEPSTAKES DIVISION OF PRIZE MONEY FOR SWEEPSTAKES AND VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

After 30% of remaining entry fee (for each division) will be retained by club for expenses.

 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

AKC® Code of Sportsmanship and Civility

Preface: The tradition of competitive purebred dog events predates 1884—the year the American Kennel Club (AKC®) was founded. Those involved in these sports share core values, including a strong commitment to sportsmanship and a welcoming, respectful culture that embraces the diverse community united by a love of dogs.

These values are evident across all aspects of the sport: conformation, performance, companion, and family dog activities. Many believe that the enduring principles of sportsmanship and civility are key reasons the sport has thrived for over 140 years.

Recognizing that periodically reaffirming our shared values strengthens our community, the revised code will be shared widely to highlight the foundational values and principles that define the sport.

- Sportspeople always place the welfare of their dog above all else.
- Sportspeople prioritize the long-term health and preservation of their breed, making decisions that reflect a deep commitment to responsible breeding and ownership.
- Sportspeople respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational.
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.
- Sportspeople actively support the education and mentorship of newcomers, helping them learn the rules, values, and traditions of the sport in a respectful way.
- Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct.
- Sportspeople treat fellow exhibitors, judges, officials, volunteers, spectators, and AKC staff with dignity and respect, regardless of experience, background, or differences in opinion.
- Sportspeople are committed to fair play, honesty, courtesy, and competition, approaching both winning and losing with grace.
- Sportspeople understand that strong competition and civility can—and should—coexist. They appreciate the quality of their competitors, and the effort put forth by others.
- Sportspeople uphold their responsibilities to the sport of purebred dogs and refuse to let personal gain or self-interest influence their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsperson judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.
